Dear Friend,

HAVEN has been a safe place for survivors in our community since 1977.

HAVEN has consistently brought vital government funds to our community to address the needs of survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, and human trafficking. We have grown beyond addressing immediate safety needs to include long-term housing assistance, ongoing counseling and peer support, economic empowerment programs, and youth intervention and prevention programs.

Last year, HAVEN assisted over 2,000 people, with just over 50 advocates providing services, at eight different locations in the county who turned to us when they needed safety.

We are only able to continue these services because of community support through our fundraising events.

Your sponsorship of HAVEN helps provide a solid foundation for our continued growth. It opens the door to safety for survivors in our community.

Your investment in the safety of our community continues the flow of state and federal funds to our local economy to assist survivors. These funds have directly provided survivors with assistance to keep them housed. In Their Shoes

In Their Shoes is the current iteration of the Walk a Mile event. HAVEN wishes to highlight ALL survivors of sexual abuse and the name change is inclusive of all the shoes they wear.

Our prior focus leaned into men's use of violence against women. This has been the heart of our movement for decades and was the core of the International Men's March, Walk a Mile in Her Shoes. The importance of that approach to our work is still relevant and needed. But it's not the only facet, and it doesn't reflect the experience of all survivors in our community.

Kick Up Your Heels is a cocktail reception that pays tribute to HAVEN's supporters and provides our community updates on HAVEN's work and its mission.
